



A Select Entry Class for High Achieving Students Year 7-9

At Bayside P-12 College, we offer an opportunity for highly motivated and academically able students. This is a select entry class. The focus is on providing students with a challenging and rewarding learning environment. Our program aims to build a strong culture of ambition and achievement, where students are encouraged to undertake opportunities for extension, challenge and leadership. This program is offered at both junior campuses: Altona North and Williamstown. Interested students are required to sit an entrance exam in Math and English.

Vision Statement |

The Academic Achievers Program is a comprehensive academic initiative that spans from Year 7 to Year 9, specifically created for students with a passion for learning. The program is built around an explicit instructional model that challenges and extends students while utilizing an evidence-based enriched curriculum.

Students engage with content at a metacognitive level, fostering deeper understanding and connection across various key learning areas. They are encouraged to make interdisciplinary links, apply real-world problem-solving, and participate in our school-wide wellbeing program, which supports their overall development.

Academic Achievers |

We aim to enrich student learning through:

- A curriculum that exceeds the expected learning level
- Higher-order thinking tasks to foster critical and creative problem-solving skills
- Opportunities for potential acceleration into VCE courses as early as Year 10
- A wide variety of engaging excursions and learning experiences
- A compulsory quality music program

Program Structure |

Students are grouped for all their core studies. This is in English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities, Music, and Physical Education. They may choose electives in Year 9. Students stay in the same grouping from Year 7 through to Year 9. At the end of each year, students will undergo a review of their placement in our program. This will include testing and teacher recommendation. Parents will be kept informed of the progress of their child throughout the year.

Participation in the School Community |

Students are expected to participate in the broader aspects of college life. Students will be given opportunities to participate in Maths and Science challenges, Debating and Public Speaking, Community projects and the Arts. Our Year 9 students have access to Science at Monash University and "Maths Challenge" from our Senior Maths Faculty. Other extension activities are offered throughout the year.





Instrumental Music |

All students in the Academic Achievers class are encouraged to learn and play a musical instrument. Students have the opportunity to come together as part of the Junior College Band, which performs at major College events throughout the year. The music program operates across both the Williamstown and Altona North campuses and includes campus-specific ensembles, providing students with a range of performance and collaboration opportunities.

Options for Acceleration at the Senior Campus |

The program aims for students to access VCE subjects at Year 10 level. Students will be encouraged to study Advanced Maths and Advanced English and can select from an area of the VCE offered to Year 10. Every year, most of our top achievers in Year 12 have been past participants in the Academic Achievers program. We are proud of the opportunities this program affords our students.

Application Process for 2027 |

Our Academic Achievers Program has delivered excellent outcomes for over 16 years.

Parents and prospective students should be aware that there have been departmental changes on how schools can run testing for special programs like the Academic Achievers Program. Students can now only apply for the program AFTER they have been offered a mainstream place at the college.

Parents who are interested in their child joining the Academic Achievers Program must reside within the enrolment for the school. Once enrolments are finalised, in late July, we will be contacting all applicants for the opportunity to sit for the Academic Achievers select entry testing. The test will be on **Friday, 4th September, 9:00am-11:30am, 2026.**
